MALBEC - SYRAH

Varietal: 50% Malbec - 50% Syrah

VINEYARDS:

Malbec of Santa Blanca, Maipú. Low trellis of 20 years old, with a yield of 8 thousand kg per hectare. Syrah from Montecaseros, San Martín. Parrales in sandy soil of 40 years of seniority, and yield of 12 thousand kg per ha. Both vineyards have traditional irrigation system.

HARVEST:

2018. Manual harvest with boxes during the last two weeks of March.

AGING:

For 6 months, 30% of the wine rests in French oak barrels. The remaining 70% rests in stainless steel tanks in contact with American oak staves.

TASTING:

Dark and intense red wine.

The nose combines in an impeccable balance the spicy aromas of Syrah, with the fruit of Malbec.

Highlights notes of vanilla and leather. In the mouth is a wine of good acidity, flavors of plum jam and black fruits, it presents balanced, soft tannins and delicate sensations, with a sweet and long finish.

Alcohol: 13,50 % v/v
