Malbec

Varietal: 100% Malbec

Vineyard:

Santa Blanca, Maipú. Low trellis, 20 years old. Sandy soil and flooding irrigation. It yields 7 to 8 thousand kilos per hectare.

Harvest:

2017. Manual harvest with boxes during the last week of March.

Aging:

30% of the wine rests for 12 months in American oak barrels. The remaining 70% rests in stainless steel tanks in contact with French oak staves.

Tasting:

Intense purple-colored wine, brilliant and clean.

On the nose, it has Malbec characteristic fruits of Maipú: ripe plums, dark chocolate and mild leather notes.

In the mouth, it is sweet and gentle, with a delicate vanilla touch. Its aging in oak gives the wine complexity and a long finishing.

Aging potential: 6 years

Alcohol: 13,80 % v/v
